

Allium Chivette features lovely edible flowers and foliage. Standing out in the garden at 12-15" high and 8-12" wide, with lavender-purple flowers with a purple stripe, Chivette has upright blue-green foliage all season long.

- ❖ **Zone hardiness** Zone 3 - 10
- ❖ **Bloom time:** Spring through early summer.
- ❖ **Habit:** Upright
- ❖ **Branching:** Densely branched
- ❖ **Flower size:** 1.00 – 1.25"
- ❖ **Flower form:** Double
- ❖ **Height:** 12-15" high
- ❖ **Spread:** 15-18" wide
- ❖ **Spacing:** 8-12" apart
- ❖ **Exposure:** Performs best in sun.
- ❖ **Water:** Prefers regular moisture but can tolerate drought.
- ❖ **Fertilizer:** Moderate applications at 150-200 ppm.
- ❖ **PGR:** Not recommended
- ❖ **pH:** 5.8-6.2
- ❖ **EC:** EC 0.5 – 1.8 (50-150 ppm)
- ❖ **Temperature for rooting:** 65 – 72 °F
- ❖ **Pinching:** N/A
- ❖ **Scheduling:** Plant 1 plug per qt for finish in 6-8 weeks, 1-2 plugs per 1 gallon for finish in 8-10 weeks.
- ❖ **Pests:** Scout for flower thrips.
- ❖ **Disease:** None
- ❖ **Breeder:** Brent Horvath – Intrinsic Perennials

Always follow label instructions carefully. Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.

Notes: This is a mostly sterile Allium, with a high tolerance to botrytis & powdery mildew.
