

Leucanthemum FlowerPower™ features large and vibrant single white flowers on short, strong stems. FlowerPower™ is produced from stock plants which are certified tested clean from crown gall diseases.

- ❖ **Plant Name:** Leucanthemum FlowerPower™
- ❖ **Zone hardiness:** Zone 4 -9
- ❖ **Bloom time:** Summer through fall, approx. weeks 26-40+
- ❖ **Habit:** Groundcover
- ❖ **Branching:** Densely branched
- ❖ **Flower size:** 2-3"
- ❖ **Flower form:** Single
- ❖ **Height:** 18-24" high
- ❖ **Spread:** 24-32" wide
- ❖ **Spacing:** 24-30" apart
- ❖ **Exposure:** Performs best in sun.
- ❖ **Water:** Prefers and performs best with even moisture.
- ❖ **Fertilizer:** Moderate 150-200 ppm
- ❖ **PGR:** Not recommended if grown cold. If necessary, 2,500 ppm daminoside (B9) spray, or 20-25 ppm paclobutrazol spray.
- ❖ **pH:** 5.8-6.2
- ❖ **EC:** EC 0.5 – 1.8 (50-150 ppm)
- ❖ **Temperature for rooting:** 65-72°F
- ❖ **Pinching:** Pinch at transplant, then as needed.
- ❖ **Scheduling:** URC root in 7-14 days, plugs ready for transplant in 14-28 weeks. Plant 1 plug per qt for finish in 8-10 weeks, 1 plug per 1 gallon for finish in 12-14 weeks
- ❖ **Pests:** Scout for aphids, two spotted spider mites & flower thrips
- ❖ **Disease:** Watch for fusarium & root rots.
- ❖ **Breeder:** G2 – Rick Grazzini



Always follow label instructions carefully. Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.

Notes: This is a mostly sterile Leucanthemum, with a high tolerance to botrytis.
