

Dianthus Everbloom™

Zone hardiness: Zone 4 - 9
Bloom time: Spring through fall
Habit: Groundcover
Branching: Densely branched
Flower size: 1.25 – 1.5”
Flower form: Semi double to double
Height: 6-8” high
Spread: 18-24” wide
Spacing: 15-18” apart
Exposure: Performs best in sun.
Water: Prefers regular moisture, but will tolerate dry conditions.
Fertilizer: 50-75 ppm N
PGR: Not recommended
pH: 6.0-6.4
EC: EC 0.5 – 1.8 (50-150 ppm)
Temperature for rooting: 65-70 °F
Pinching: Pinch at transplant, then as needed.
Scheduling: URC root in 7-10 days and plugs transplant in 3-4 weeks. Flowers from URC in 8-10 weeks and from plug transplant in 5-6 weeks. Plant 1 plug per qt for finish in 6-8 weeks, 2-3 plugs per 1 gallon for finish in 8-10 weeks, 3 plugs per 2 gallon for finish in 10-12 weeks
Pests: Scout for aphids & flower thrips.
Disease: None
- Always follow label instructions carefully.
Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.
