

Artemisia **GardenGhost™** USPP 33,773



- Breeder:** Rick Grazzini, GardenGenetics
 - Zone hardiness:** Zone 3 - 10
 - Habit:** Groundcover
 - Branching:** Densely branched
 - Height:** 12-14" high
 - Spread:** 24-30" wide
 - Spacing:** 24-30" apart
 - Exposure:** Performs best in sun.
 - Water:** Grows best with regular moisture, but tolerates dry conditions very well.
 - Fertilizer:** Moderate applications at 150-200 ppm.
 - PGR:** Not recommended
 - pH:** 5.8-6.2
 - EC:** EC 0.5 – 1.8 (50-150 ppm)
 - Temperature for rooting:** 65-72°F
 - Pinching:** Pinch at transplant, then as needed for optimal shape.
 - Scheduling:** Roots from URC in 7-14 days, plugs ready to transplant 14-28 weeks. Plant 1 plug per qt for finish in 8-10 weeks, 3 plugs per 1 gallon for finish in 12-14 weeks
 - Pests:** Scout for aphids, two spotted spider mites.
 - Disease:** None
- Always follow label instructions carefully.
Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.

A+ Groundcover

In trials GardenGhost™ has shown a high tolerance to botrytis.

With dove-grey serrated foliage, this plant portrays a ghostly appearance in the garden. Starting out slightly green in color, watch GardenGhost™ mature throughout the season to a nice bright silvery foliage accent piece. GardenGhost™ lends itself to being perfectly mounded at 12-24" tall and 24-30" wide.
