What makes 'New Moon' distinctive?

Glance at this new moon more than just once a month! The latest ornamental onion Allium 'New Moon' stands out with its large and long bloom times and striking blue-green foliage measuring about 3/8" wide. This plant showcases lavender-colored flowers from mid to late summer. Standing tall on 12-15" stems, it thrives in full sun and some light shade. This late bloomer will add a pop of color to any garden!



Resilient and Resistant

Can withstand drought and needs little to no maintenance while being resistant to deer and most rodents.



Unique Full Shape

Full and spherical flowers are the perfect contrast to other plants in gardens and bouquets.



Eye-Catching Color

The lavender flowers are bright while creating a calm environment complimenting the blue-green foliage below.

Zone hardiness: 4-9

Bloom time: Mid-late summer.

Habit: Upright

Branching: singular and upright

Flower size: 5cm

Flower form: Individual

Height: 12-15" high

Spread: 6-18" wide

Exposure: Performs best in full sun and some light shade.

Water: Prefers regular moisture, let dry in between, can tolerate drought.

Fertilizer: medium amount required, through foliar feed

PGR: None necessary

pH: 5.8-6.5

EC: 1.5-3

Temperature for rooting: needs cooled temperatures

Pinching: None

Scheduling: Early spring to early summer

Pests: Onion flies (Delia), onion thrips, and stem nematode (Ditylenchus)

Disease: Smut, rust, smudge (Colletotrichum), onion white rot

Always follow label instructions carefully.

Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.
