

Allium 'Blue Moon'

Breeder: Intrinsic Perennials, Pioneer Gardens

Zone hardiness: 4-9

Bloom time: Early-late summer

Habit: Upright

Branching: Singular and upright

Flower size: 2"

Flower form: Rounded, Individual

Height: 18-20"

Spread: 18-24"

Exposure: Full sun-partial sun

Water: Prefers regular moisture, let dry in between, can tolerate drought.

Fertilizer: medium amount required, through foliar feed

PGR: None

pH: 5.8-6.5

EC: 1.5-3

Temperature for rooting: needs cooled temperatures

Pinching: None

Scheduling: Early spring-summer

Pests: Onion flies (Delia), onion thrips, and stem nematode (Ditylenchus)

Disease: Smut, rust, smudge (Colletotrichum), onion white rot

Always follow label instructions carefully.

Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.
