Zone hardiness: Zone 3 - 8

Bloom time: Summer long through August.

Habit: Upright

Branching: Some, mild branching

Flower form: Spike

Height: 20-24" high

Spread: 18"

Spacing: 18-24" apart

Exposure: Full sun

Water: Prefers regular moisture, but will tolerate dry conditions.

Temperature for rooting: 65-68°F

Pinching: Not required

Scheduling: 10-weeks from plug for 1.5 Gallon

Pests: None known

Disease: Watch for Powdery Mildew

Always follow label instructions carefully.

Test on a small portion of the crop prior to widespread application.

This lovely lady is a taller, true-blue Veronica and offers us beautiful plumes over bright green foliage.

A coastal-friendly perennial, that tolerates summer heat very well and shows exceptional salt tolerance. Veronica Seaside will be found in bloom summer through August on 20-24" stems. This hummingbird favorite plant is a great addition to any perennial garden.
